The Moore County Board of Education met at Central Office in Carthage on Monday, December 10, 2018, at 5:00 pm for its regular business meeting.

Helena Wallin-Miller called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm.

I. CALL TO ORDER

VII. BOARD COMMENTS

Chair Wallin-Miller shared the following comments: It is not the Board's practice to comment after public address, but I would like to at this time given the energy in the room. I want to offer my deepest sympathy to all of you who knew and loved Samantha Davis. While I didn't know Sam personally, I certainly have learned so much about this remarkable young woman since her passing from comments made by her friends and family at her funeral and from all of you here today. In fact, I spoke at a Board Meeting right after her funeral noting how her father's "10 percent more" comment really struck a chord with me too. You are honoring her so much by your desire to keep her memory alive. I know you are aware of our practice not to name entire schools after individuals. This particular year has been difficult to many in our school system not only with Sam's passing, but also a long-time MCS teacher and strong advocate for our schools in retirement - School Board Member Charles Lambert, Union Pines graduate Cooper Ellington, Southern Pines Primary Student Linton "LJ" Numbers to name just a few. We've also lost community members this past year - like Linda Hubbard, Felton Capel, and Fred Walden - all who have shown considerable commitment to our entire Moore County School community through their volunteerism and actions both in and out of the schools. Our practice has been instead to encourage family and friends to work with schools to consider meaningful recognition to honor the student or staff member at the campus where they had the most impact. Ways to honor an important individual in the life of a school include naming portions of their school (e.g., gyms, tracks, auditoriums) or creating lasting memorials (e.g., gardens, playgrounds) or even starting new programs (e.g., kindness campaigns or awards, scholarships). The Board would be interested in hearing your thoughts in the future on how to preserve her spirit and memory in those ways. My heart is with all those who knew and loved Sam and I admire your passion to share her spirit by being here today and from the petition you started. Thank you for being here and showing the Board your compassion and your advocacy. The world is bright knowing there are students ready to ask questions and be engaged. I am proud of each and every one of you.

Bruce Cunningham commented that as he listened to each student he felt as though he was watching a part of Samantha Davis in the room, as her positive impact on others was evident. Mr. Cunningham further noted that, unlike with schools, a substantial number of specific facilities, rooms, tracks, libraries, and stadiums have been named in honor of an individual associated with that particular school. Mr. Cunningham encouraged all who were supportive of naming the new school after Samantha to consider advocating for

honoring her in this manner. Mr. Cunningham expressed his appreciation for the and passion and commitment shown by all who were working to honor Samantha's memory. Stacey Caldwell echoed Chair Wallin-Miller's and Mr. Cunningham's remarks and expressed her respect for the courage shown by all who spoke on behalf of Samantha under such difficult circumstances.

Board recessed for s short break at 7:21 pm and returned at approximately 7:29 pm.

VIII. BOARD ACTION

A. Final Student Assignment Plan for New Elementary School on Camp Easter Road:

During the School Board's December 3, 2018 organizational meeting and work session, Mr. Birath presented a final student assignment plan for the new elementary school on Camp Easter Road. During its November 5, 2018 regular business meeting, the School Board authorized: (a.) posting of the final 2018-2019 proposed student assignment plan for the new school on Camp Easter Road on the website; (b.) the provision of a web site portal that would enable public comment on the plan; and (c.) the conduct of a public hearing regarding the plan on November 15, 2018 in the Carthage Elementary auditorium. Only two speakers addressed the Board during the public hearing. Both stated their support of the map as proposed and the opportunities the Board has identified for further investigation during the next phase of student assignment evaluations. The online portal closed at the end of the business day on November 15, 2018. Nine comments were received through the portal. Six comments supported the plan as presented and three comments expressed a desire for more students from the Whispering Pines extraterritorial jurisdiction to be assigned to the new school. Ed Dennison made a motion to approve the proposed student assignment plan for the new school on Camp Easter Road as presented. Dr. Betty Wells Brown seconded, and the motion carried 7-0.

B. Name of New Elementary School on Camp Easter Road: During the School Board's organizational meeting and work session on December 3, 2018, Mr. Birath presented a final summary of public comment on a name for the new elementary school on Camp Easter Road. At the October 1, 2018, Work Session/Special Called Meeting, the School Board endorsed a process for the superintendent to develop a selection of names for the new elementary school on Camp Easter Road. A website portal was available for the public to suggest names for the new school from October 2 through October 19, 2018. Staff also worked directly with the principals of Sandhills Farm Life and Vass-Lakeview Elementary schools to encourage the active participation of their students, staff members and parents since the new school's enrollment will be comprised almost exclusively of students from those two schools. There were 504 submissions to the portal. Accounting for duplicated submissions, the portal generated 66 unique suggestions. The staff conducted additional research and submitted additional names based on that research. Finally, the staff invited School Board members to offer their own suggestions. A complete list of 108 possible names generated by the portal, the staff and School Board members is attached. Twenty-one submissions involved the individual names of people. While School Board Policy does not prohibit the School Board from naming schools after individual people, Moore County Schools does not have a precedent for applying individual names to entire schools. In accordance with its policy, the Board has applied the names of individuals to auxiliary facilities, such as gymnasiums, auditoriums and outdoor athletic venues. The process for requesting the naming of auxiliary facilities can be found in board

policy 7550. The staff then analyzed submissions, eliminating those with the same and/or similar names of similar educational facilities in the geographic vicinity, and those that were already trademarked by non-profit and for-profit organizations. Staff offered the following “short list” of possible names for the new elementary school:

- McDeeds Creek Elementary;
- Fairway Elementary;
- Pine Meadow Elementary;
- Camp Easter Elementary; and
- Piney Woods Elementary.

At the November 5, 2018 regular business meeting, the Board approved the short list of names to be published on the website portal for public feedback. The portal was opened from November 6 through November 21, 2018. The portal allowed respondents to indicate whether they “support” or “don’t support” each proposed school name and the ability to comment on why or why not they support that name. “Camp Easter Elementary School” received highest level of support among the respondents who supported at least one of the options. Bruce Cunningham made a motion to select the name for the new elementary school on Camp Easter Road as McDeeds Creek Elementary School. Elizabeth Carter seconded, and the motion carried 7-0.

IX. FINAL BOARD COMMENTS

Bruce Cunningham expressed satisfaction of another good meeting. Chair Wallin-Miller commented on the holiday programs beginning and end of semester programs in which the Board will try to attend. Chair Wallin-Miller expressed her appreciation to teachers and staff to keep the pace going during the busy time.

X. CLOSED SESSION

Second Closed Session was not held.

XI. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, Ed Dennison made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Dr. Betty Wells Brown seconded, and the motion carried 7-0.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:46 pm.
